

# Angkor Archaeological Park

## Visit The Famous Angkor Temples



Only 6 km from Siem Reap lays the 400 square kilometer large Angkor Archaeological park. This park is the home of over 300 magnificent temple ruins from the Angkorian era, including the famous Angkor Wat, Bayon and Ta Prohm. Most of the temples were constructed between the 9th and 12 century and they are a truly impressive display of ancient Khmer architecture, art and civilization.

### Practical Information

Don't forget that this is a holy place, and it is recommended to dress according to the local customs (cover your shoulders and knees etc.)

Avoid climbing and do damage to the temples, to ensure that people in the future also can enjoy them like you do now.

The temple area can sometimes be a bit crowded so don't be afraid to ask your driver or guide for the best route to avoid the crowds.

Entrance fee: 1-day pass \$20. 3-day pass \$40 & 7-day pass \$60

The entrance ticket also includes some of the temples outside the main complex, such as Banteay Srey, Kbal Spean and Phnom Kraom

Note: Phnom Kulen, Koh Ker and Beng Melea have separate entrance fees



### How to get there

The temples can be reached either by bicycle, moto, tuk-tuk, or car. If you decide to go by bicycle, remember to drink a lot of water. There are also electrical bicycles available.

If you decide to go motorized, the most practical way is to rent a driver for the full day.
