

Beng Melea

Less Crowded Favorite



Located 63 km east from Siem Reap lays Beng Melea. On the way to this temple you will pass beautiful Cambodian countryside and local villages. This quiet and isolated temple ruin gives you a chance to enjoy walking around in a temple almost by yourself. Beng Melea is overgrown like the famous jungle temple Ta Prom, but it is very lightly touristed. This gives you excellent photo opportunities.

Practical Information

Don't forget that this is a holy place so it's a good idea to dress according to the local customs. Cover your shoulders and knees etc. Avoid climbing and do damage to the temples so that people in the future also can enjoy them like you do now

Entrance:

Beng Melea is not included in the general admission ticket. It has a separate \$5 entrance fee that you pay at the temple.



How to get there

Beng Melea is reachable by moto, tuk-tuk, car or van. The trip to the temple takes a half day, and can easily be combined with a trip to Koh Ker. For a combined tour you should plan for a full day.
