

Cambodian Cultural Village

A little bit of everything in Cambodia



This cultural attraction opened in September 2003 and has a total area of 210 000 square meters. Its intention is to introduce visitors to Cambodian culture and history. The Cultural village contains a wax museum and a large park with 1/20 scale models of important cultural sites and landmarks in Cambodia. Inside the park they also have 11 unique villages, each representing different culture heritages and characteristics of different ethnic groups in Cambodia.

Practical Information

The Village is open between 09.00am to 09.00 pm and the admission fee is \$12 per person with guides available for \$5

Everyday they have live traditional dance and music shows including a traditional Khmer wedding show.

Its best to call in advance to confirm the times of these shows.
