

Kbal Spean

The River Of A Thousand Lingas



Located 50 km from Siem Reap at Kulen mountains. A beautiful 2 km uphill path in the jungle will take you to Kbal Spean and the river of a thousand lingas which truly is a spectacular carved riverbed. Around the area you will also find several impressive carvings of various Hindu gods. The best time to visit this place is between September and December when the waterfall and the river is full with water.

Practical Information

Don't forget that this is a holy place so it's a good idea to dress according to the local customs. Cover your shoulders and knees etc. Avoid climbing and do damage to the temples so that people in the future also can enjoy them like you do now

Remember to bring plenty of water for the walk up to Kbal Spean as there is none available beyond the parking area

Entrance is included in the general admission fee for the Angkor archaeological park

Entrance to the area closes at 03.00pm



How to get there

Kbal Spean is reachable by moto, tuk-tuk, car or van and takes at least half a day. You have to depart from Siem Reap in the morning. This trip can be combined with a visit to Banteay Srey, Phnom Kulen and/or the landmine museum.
