

Landmine Museum

Learn more about one of Cambodia's maybe biggest problem



Akira, a former soldier, created this museum when he started to work as a deminer after the war. It contains an expanded exhibition displaying information about the conflict and a verity of defused mines, bombs and other ordinances. Akira is sometimes around and speaks of his experience as a young soldier. The museum is located 6 km south of the beautiful Banteay Srey temple.

Practical Information

Cambodia suffers one of the worst landmine problems in the world. This museum is a good place to visit if you want to learn more about the situation here.

The proceedings from the museum goes to a mine awareness campaigns and support an on-site orphanage, rehabilitation centre and a training facility.
