Free guided tours in English, Khmer, French or Japanese are available daily between 07.00am to 05.00pm.

There is a retail/souvenir shop open daily from 08.00am to 05.30pm where you can buy clothing, interior design products and accessories.

For centuries Cambodia have been home to some of the worlds most beautiful handicrafts. The years of war and poverty almost destroyed these prosperous traditions but today these art forms are making a comeback. The Artisans d'Angkor silk farm located 16 km west from Siem Reap produce some of the best silk in the country. You can get a guided tour and see the entire silk creation process, from growing the mulberry bushes, breeding the worms, silk extraction, spinning and refinement, traditional ikat dying, pattern creation to looming. This is a fascinating farm/workshop well worth the visit.



How to get there

The Silk farm is reachable by moto, tuk-tuk, car or van. The trip and a guided tour takes a couple of hours.

Can be combined with a trip to West baray, Sangkheum center or National Centre for Khmer ceramics revival.
