

Village Tour

The tour starts at 08.00 am and finishes around 04.00 pm

Tour program;

After a short introduction at Soria Moria the tour will take you along countryside roads surrounded by rice paddy fields and vegetable farms. The first stop is at a shadow puppet workshop, and a stone carving workshop next door. The trip continues past Bakong temple until you reach the second stop at Roulus market. Here you will have a chance to walk around, taste fresh fruits and drink sugar cane juice, here we will purchase some fresh ingredients for our lunch. This is a local countryside market, so don't be surprised if they have never seen a foreigner before. The tour then continues to Chan So Village, where you will be served a fresh coconut, handpicked from a coconut palm, and we will eat lunch at a Cambodian family's house. In this village you will have the opportunity to go for an ox-cart ride and interact with the local villagers. After lunch and relaxation the trip continues to Lolei. Along the way we will stop at a sticky rice stall for tasting and learning how the rice sticks are made. The last stop on this tour is at Lolei Pagoda where you will experience a visit to a Cambodian pagoda. You will learn about why and when the locals visit pagodas, and if you would like to, you may get a monk shower or blessing here.

Think about;

Cambodia can get very hot so remember to bring sunscreen, and drink plenty of water along the way.

Please keep in mind that during this tour you will visit people in their homes and in their everyday lives. The tour goes off the tourist track, where they still have traditional views, so think about how you dress. It's polite if you cover your shoulders and knees.

To minimize the impact your visit, ask your guide if you are not sure how to behave. Remember, it is polite to ask for permission before you take pictures of persons.

You will receive a big smile if you can say a few phrases in the local language, Khmer.

Tour includes;

All transportation as described in the program and an English speaking guide.

All activities and entrance tickets, including ox-cart ride.

Drinks; bottled water, sugar cane juice & coconut juice.

Food; fresh fruits, sticky rice & home made Khmer lunch.

Donation to the pagoda, and a krorma or sarong to keep as a souvenir.

Transportation;

1 pax by moto, 2-4 pax by car, 5-10 pax by Van.




A day in a Cambodian life
